

Retake a Course

Enrolling in a course gives you access to it for a year, and you can watch the video or take the quiz unlimited times during that time.

Because American CME courses provide 30 minutes of instruction for .5 credit hours, some people opt to take a course twice to earn one credit hour. If you want another .5 credit hours and a second certificate, but it hasn't been a year since you first enrolled, follow these steps:

1. Navigate to the completed course.
